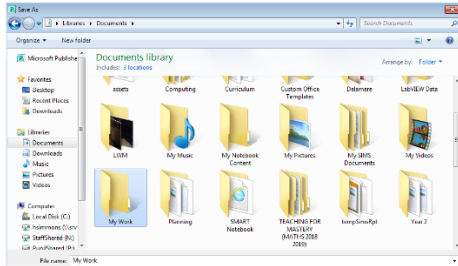
Five Ways to Wellbeing

Trackpad	A touch-sensitive surface that lets you interact with your Chromebook through finger movements.
Shutdown	To turn off a computer or laptop.
Minimise	A feature that hides an application.
Restore Down	A button in the title bar which takes an application from full size to normal size.
Save	Make a copy of a file.
Internet	A network of computers linked all over the world.

Y2 phonic check or words you enter yourself.</p> <p>Teaching ideas for Reading Robot</p>
<p>PICNIC on PLUTO</p> <p>A version of 'Buried Treasure'. Blend to read the words on the snacks. Are they real or fake? Great for: Practising blending</p>	<p>Word Trucks</p> <p>A tricky word (and other FVW) backwards game. Great for: Practising reading tricky words</p>
