Vocabulary

Format	A particular layout for text or data.
Bold	Text that is darkened to help emphasise a word or part of a text.
Underline	A section of text in a document where the words have a line running beneath them.
Italics	It is a style of font that slants the letters evenly to the right.
Font	A design for a set of characters or text.
Copy and Paste	A way to copy information from the screen into the computer's memory and paste it elsewhere without re-typing.
Undo	A function performed to reverse the action of an earlier action.

Redo	A function performed to restore an action.
Chart	Another term for a graph or other way of presenting information
Data	Units of information that can be collected for any topic or purpose.
Google Sheets	A computer program that represents information in a grid of rows and columns.
Google Slides	A computer program that represents information in a presentation format.
Google Docs	A computer word-processor that lets you create and format documents.
PaintZ	A simple paint program for creating and editing drawings and other images
Presentation	A speech or talk in which a new product, idea, or piece of work is shown and explained to an audience.
