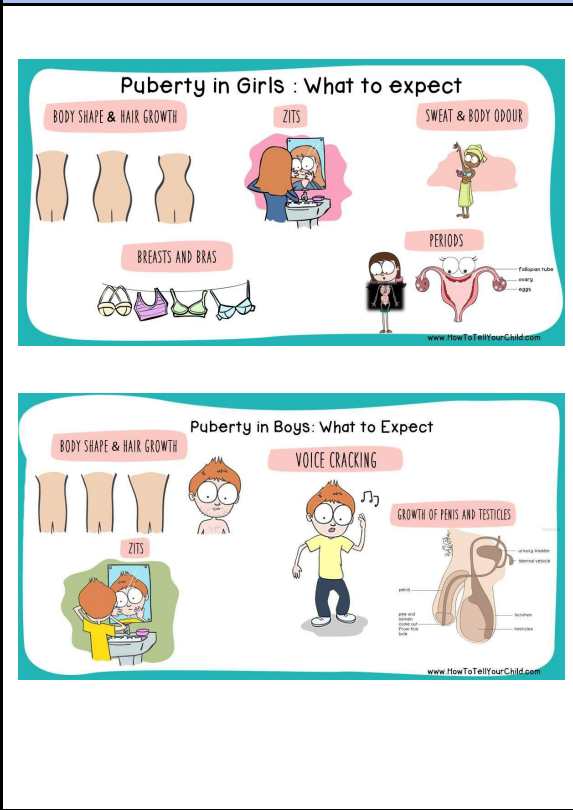

Vocabulary	
Puberty	Puberty is the process of physical changes through which a child's body matures into an adult body capable of sexual reproduction.
Lifecycle	the series of changes in the life of an organism including reproduction.
Reproduction	the production of offspring by a sexual or asexual process.
Physical	Relating to the body
Breasts	The two soft protruding organs on the upper front of a woman's body which secrete milk after childbirth
Sperm	A male reproductive cell that can unite with an egg to form a new cell.
Egg	The female reproductive cell
Pubic hair	Hair that grows in private areas during puberty
Emotional feelings	Feelings such as happiness or anger.
