Vocabulary	
Money	Money can be defined as anything that people use to buy goods and services. Money is what many people receive for selling their own things or services.
Names of coins and notes	Eg, 1p, 10p, £1 etc.
Earn	To receive money as payment for work that you do.. to get something that you deserve.
Borrow	Take and use money belonging to someone else) with the intention of returning it.
Bank account	An arrangement made with a bank whereby one may deposit and withdraw money.
Savings	Saving is is putting money away and not spending it with the intention of building up a lump sum of money.
Spend	Give (money) to pay for goods, services, or so as to benefit someone or something.
